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**ORDER:**

The following Notification shall be published in the Telangana Gazette.

**NOTIFICATION**

In exercise of the powers conferred by article 309 of the Constitution of India read with sub-sections (3) and (4) of section 169, sub-sections (3) and (4) of section 195 and section 243 of the Telangana Panchayat Raj Act, 2018 (Act No.5 of 2018) and section 78 and section 99 of the Telangana Education Act, 1982 (Act No. 1 of 1982), read with sub-section (1) of section 23 of the Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education Act, 2009 (Central Act No.35 of 2009) and the National Council for Teacher Education (Determination of Minimum Qualifications for Persons to be Recruited as Education Teachers and Physical Education Teachers in Pre-Primary, Primary, Upper Primary, Secondary, Senior Secondary or Intermediate Schools or Colleges) Regulations, 2014 dt.12.11.2014, the Governor of Telangana hereby makes the following amendments the Telangana State Direct Recruitment for the posts of Teachers (Scheme of Selection) Rules 2023 issued in G.O.Ms.No.25, School Education (Ser.III) Department, dt.05.09.2023 as amended subsequently from time to time :

**AMENDMENT**

In the said rules,-

The following rule shall be **added** to **Rule 4, Sub-rule (ii) (I) from (A) to (L)**, namely,

**(1) " School Assistants:-**

- a) **Must possess a Graduate / Post Graduate Degree in concerned subject (or its allied subjects as given in the Annexure to this G.O.) from a University recognized by UGC with at least 45% marks in either Graduation or Post Graduation (or its equivalent) (in case of SC / ST / BC / Differently abled candidates, the minimum marks shall be 40%) and Bachelor of Education (B.Ed.) from National Council of Teacher Education recognized institution {in accordance with the National Council for Teacher Education (Form of application for recognition, the time limit of submission of application, determination of norms and standards for recognition of teacher education programmes and permission to start new course or training) Regulations, 2002 notified on 13.11.2002 and National Council for Teacher Education (Recognition Norms and Procedure) Regulations, 2007 notified on 10.12.2007}**

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Provided that minimum percentage of marks in graduation shall not be applicable to those incumbents who had already taken admission to the Bachelor of Education or Bachelor of Elementary Education or equivalent courses prior to the 29.07.2011.

- (2) The following rule shall be added to Rule 4, Sub-rule (ii) (I) (M), namely -

**“School Assistant (Physical Education)**

- a) Must possess a Bachelor’s degree with Physical Education as an elective subject from a University recognized by UGC with 45% marks (in case of SC/ST & BC, it shall be 40%) and participation in National or State or Inter- University competitions in sports or games or athletics recognized by Association of Indian University or Indian Olympic Association.

OR

- b) Must possess a Bachelor’s degree from a University recognized by UGC with 45% marks (in case of SC/ST & BC, it shall be 40%) and have participated in National or State or Inter-University sports or games or athletics.

OR

- c) Must possess a Bachelor’s Degree with minimum 50% marks (in case of SC/ST & BC, the minimum marks shall be 45%).

- (3) The following rule shall be added to Rule 4, Sub-rule (ii) (III) A to G, namely,

**“Language Pandit:-**

- a) Must possess a Graduate / Post Graduate Degree in concerned language as one of the optional /Graduation literature and BOL in concerned language from a University recognized by UGC with at least 45% marks in either Graduation or Post Graduation (or its equivalent) (in case of SC / ST / BC / Differently abled candidates, the minimum marks shall be 40%) and pass in Bachelor of Education (B.Ed.)/Special Education in B.Ed Course with concerned language as a methodology subject or Language Pandit training in concerned languages from National Council of Teacher Education recognized institution {in accordance with the National Council for Teacher Education (Form of application for recognition, the time limit of submission of application, determination of norms and standards for recognition of teacher education programmes and permission to start new course or training) Regulations, 2002 notified on 13.11.2002 and National Council for Teacher Education (Recognition Norms and Procedure) Regulations, 2007 notified on 10.12.2007}

Provided that minimum percentage of marks in graduation shall not be applicable to those incumbents who had already taken admission to the Bachelor of Education or Bachelor of Elementary Education or equivalent courses prior to the 29.07.2011.

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- (4) The following rule shall be **added** to **Rule 4, Sub-rule (ii) (IV)**, namely,-

**“Physical Education Teacher:-**

- a) **Must Possess Intermediate/ Senior Secondary/ or its equivalent recognized by the Board of Intermediate, Telangana with at least 50% marks (in case of SC/ST & BC, the minimum marks shall be 45%).**

**OR**

- b) **Candidates who have passed the Senior Secondary examination (+2) or its Equivalent and have participated in sports / games at least school / college / district level in accordance with the National Council for Teacher Education (Recognition Norms and Procedure) Regulations, 2007 notified on 10.12.2007}**

**OR**

- c) **Senior Secondary (Class XII or its equivalent) with at least 45% marks from recognized board (in case of SC / ST & BC candidates, the minimum marks shall be 40%) {in accordance with the National Council for Teacher Education (Form of application for recognition, the time limit of submission of application, determination of norms and standards for recognition of Teacher Education Programmes and permission to start new course or training) Regulations, 2002 notified on 13.11.2002.**

**OR**

- d) **Must possess a Bachelor's Degree from a university recognized by UGC.**
